### ***RE: THE INGE LOTZ CASE:***

*I studied the Legal Medical Post Mortem report of Dr Ansie Adendorff as well as the report by Mr Michael Grimm and the testimonies delivered by Prof Gert Saayman. I also had insight into the related Mollett reports.*

- 1) The measurements of wounds marked as 1(a) and 1(b) can clearly not be 30 mm and these measurements are clearly incorrect. These measurements are rather closer to 20 mm.*
- 2) The angle of incidence of the relevant photo is irrelevant, because if this was the case, all measurements would have shown the same degree of deviation – and not selectively.*
- 3) I am of the opinion that Mr Grimm's report interprets the relevant pathology incorrectly.*
- 4) Prof Saayman's opinion that the implicated hammer could predominantly be excluded, is in my opinion unjustified.*
- 5) I underwrite the Mollett report as presented in full.*

### ***SUBMISSION:***

*I have no doubt that the implicated decorative hammer was or could have been responsible for the fatal head wounds.*
